

KANAB CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 11, 2017
KANAB CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

PRESENT: Mayor Pro-Tem Brent Chamberlain, Council Members Byard Kershaw, Jeff Yates, Joe B. Wright, Recorder Joe Decker, Attorney Jeff Stott and Treasurer RaeLene Johnson. Mayor Robert Houston and Council Member Michael East excused.

WORK MEETING: The flooding from the recent rain storm was discussed. Mr. Decker said that Tom's Canyon flood control worked very well. The pond by Squaw Trail didn't have any water in it. Most of the water from this storm came from Pugh's Canyon. We still have some work to do, but it wasn't as bad as it has been in the past. There was a ditch near Sedona Valley Estates that flooded and caused flooding there, but the cause was a 48" pipe going to a 24" pipe and some of the ditch being open. It was suggested that the 24" pipe be removed and open the rest of the ditch.

Prayer was offered by Jeff Yates and the pledge was led by Byard Kershaw. Mayor Pro-Tem Chamberlain opened the regularly scheduled meeting at 6:50 p.m. and roll call was taken.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Jeff Frey expressed appreciation for the community effort on Sunday night during the rain storm. He felt everything went really well. He applauded the community.

BEER LICESNE AT 386 EAST 300 SOUTH: A motion was made by Council Member Wright and 2nd by Council Member Kershaw to approve a Class A beer license with proximity variance for Rammani Chapagain located at 386 East 300 South (the old Coleman's Exxon). Motion passed unanimously. Council Member East absent.
