In Attendance: Mayor Pro Tem Brent Chamberlain, Council Members Michael East, Celeste Meyeres, Jeff Yates and Byard Kershaw, Attorney Jeff Stott, Recorder Joe Decker and Treasurer Katherine Ohlweiler.
Mayor Robert Houston excused.

Prayer was offered by Jeff Yates and the pledge was led by Michael East. Mayor Pro Tem Brent Chamberlain called the meeting to order and roll call was taken.

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Michael East and 2nd by Byard Kershaw to approve the agenda of September 11, 2018. Motion passed.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Byard Kershaw and 2nd by Michael East to approve the minutes from August 14, 2018. Motion passed.

Approval of Accounts Payable Vouchers: A motion was made by Jeff Yates and 2nd by Celeste Meyeres to approve the accounts payable vouchers and check register dated August 28, 2018 in the amount of \$107,315.70. Motion passed. A motion was made by Celeste Meyeres and 2nd by Michael East to approve the accounts payable vouchers and check register dated September 11, 2018 in the amount of \$492,318.32. Motion passed.

Public Comment Period: None.

Proclamation Designating September 20, 2018 as Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy

Day: Mrs. Baird explained Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy and the reason they would like September 20, 2018 to be Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy Day. The Baird's friend, Jim Rafonne has a nine-year-old son who has been diagnosed with DMD and wants to raise awareness. There is no cure for DMD and children diagnosed with DMD rarely live past their teen years. Mr. Rafonne will be running in the Grand to Grand with 12 runners on his team running to raise awareness and funds to find a cure for DMD. On September 20, there will be a public event held at the Visitor Center in Kanab with Jim Rafonne to explain what he is doing and about DMD. The event will be at 4 o'clock.

A motion was made by Michael East and 2nd by Byard Kershaw to approve the proclamation designating September 20, 2018 as Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy Day. Motion passed.
