

RESOLUTION 3-2-12 R

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO CONSIDER LOCAL INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2011, the initiative ordinance titled "An Ordinance Amending the Kanab City Land Use Ordinance to Require Voter Approval of a Coal Hydro-gasification or Electric Generating Facility" was declared sufficient to qualify for the ballot pursuant to Utah Code Annotated (U.C.A.) 20A-7-507, and

WHEREAS, the Kanab City Council took no action on the proposed ordinance as authorized by U.C.A. 20A-7-501, and

WHEREAS, U.C.A. 20A-1-203 authorizes the Kanab City Council to call a special election for the purpose of submitting the initiative to the voters of Kanab City; and

WHEREAS, U.C.A. 20A-1-204 authorizes the Kanab City Council to call a special election for an initiative authorized by Utah Code Title 20A, Chapter 7, Part 5, Local Initiatives to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Kanab City that a local special election be held on the 6th day of November, 2012, for the purpose of submitting the local initiative titled "An Ordinance Amending the Kanab City Land Use Ordinance to Require Voter Approval of a Coal Hydro-gasification or Electric Generating Facility" to the voters of Kanab City.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Kanab City Council on the 27th day of March, 2012. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
