

Kanab City Heritage and Historic Preservation Board Minutes

Mace called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm. Present were:

Motion to accept the minutes of the March 7 meeting was made by John, seconded by Joyce. Motion carried.

Mace opened the public comment portion of the meeting. No one from the public was in attendance at the meeting. Therefore, there were no public comments. Mace closed the public comment portion of the meeting.

Kanab Historic Building Registry: Signage

At the beginning of the discussion, members asked whether the screen in the room could be used to project the list of homes on the Historic Building Registry. Emily explained that anything that was projected would be posted on the public website and recommended that the list not be projected because it contains owners' personal information.

Following a review of the homes on the Kanab Historic Properties list, it was agreed that this project deserves the attention of the Board.

Our efforts must be coordinated with the homeowners, including whether they want to be involved financially in upgrading the signs.

Recommendation at this time is to focus only on the posts. Conversation about funds to replace placards will take place in the future.

There was a short discussion about the importance of providing true stories of the history of the properties. The possibility of placing QR codes on the historical signs to provide digital histories of some of the homes will be discussed in more detail at a later time. Joyce will contact Kathy Brock at the Purple Sage Inn to see if she would be interested in letting pictures of the inside of her home be included in a digital history.

Action items:

Joyce will contact Waterman Welding to determine if a pattern for the pole for the signs can be made.

Mace will look into finding a group who would like to volunteer to paint the poles as a service project.

Emily will determine if the City has paint available that could be used to paint the poles. She will also investigate prices to have plaques for the signs prepared.

Standards and Documentation: There is no current standard of what it requires to have a sign. Emily will contact other cities to see if they have standards and documentation to share with us.

Completing an annual review of the historical homes was also discussed.

Historic Programming: There was a discussion about the possibility of having an all-women city council program in conjunction with the placement of the plaque honoring the all-women city council members, which must be placed at the Kanab Museum because of the stipulations of the grant that made the plaque possible. A member expressed the opinion that the plaque should be placed where the Mayor's house stood instead at the Kanab Museum.

Susan will contact Jenna Corry about possible dates, etc. for the program.

Vote on a date/time for future board meetings: Motion that the monthly meeting of the Kanab City Heritage and Historic Preservation Board will be held the first Monday of each month at 5:30 pm was made by Joyce, seconded by John. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Susan made a motion which Mace seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried. Next meeting will be Monday, May 2, at 5:30 pm.
