

## **MINUTES FOR THE BEAUTIFICATION AND SHADE TREE MEETING APRIL 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

1. **Meeting Minutes:** A motion by Donna was put forward to approve the minutes of the last meeting, Rich seconded, all in favor. No changes
2. **Updates and follow up:**  
**Terms-** Jana informed us we all had four year terms and each of our terms had expired, with the exception of Camille. Should we wish to request being on the commission for another term we would need to send a letter of intent to Joe Decker/City Manager before Thursday – his last day, or Kent Burgraff who will be the substitute city manager until a replacement can be found. Recommendations will then go before the City Council for approval.

Jana will be resigning from the committee effective immediately as she no longer holds property within the city limits.  
Our guest, Paul, although interested in being on the committee also lives outside of the city limits.

A full commission is 7 individuals, including a non-voting chair. We still are in need of someone to update the website and integrate it with the city. Arts board is a good example.

**Ordinance** - changes to reflect the Shade Tree ordinance within the Beautification ordinance will now be the responsibility of the new city manager.

**SUN Articles** -We still need to get volunteers for articles in the SUN.

**Benches** – Camille is still in the process of getting approval for additional funding for more city benches. Estimate is 11 benches at \$1,000 each. Camille will work with Kent.

**Pots** – Camille will follow up regarding getting more pots and ensuring the pots have a drip/water source.

**Budget**- our budget this year is \$5,000. We need to get approval on projects before we spend any money.

**Future Project Ideas:**

- A. Plantings down to 300N
- B. Tree plantings to maintain our Tree City designation
- C. Grant opportunities with Tree Utah. Last year \$3,000.
- D. Park in the Ranchos near new grade school
