

## Minutes of the Kanab City Heritage and Historic Preservation Board

June 5, 2023, 5:30 pm

Motion to approve the April 3 minutes was made by Mace, and seconded by Susan. Motion carried.

Public comment session of the meeting opened with Judy Habbeshaw asking if there was a date for the Museum to open. Emily answered that it is tentative, but it's expected to open this summer. Public comment session closed.

Emily introduced the possibility of the Board leading a project to refurbish the bronze plaques at the Levi Stewart Monument. After a short enthusiastic discussion about the possibilities of training and inviting the public to participate, the topic was tabled until our next meeting.

Susan received a text from Kelly Stowell that the matching grant from the Mormon National Pioneer Heritage Area has been approved. We're waiting for formal approval. She also discussed the possibility of having the monument redesigned (smaller and with less expensive materials) to reduce the cost. As a result of the possibility of a redesign, there was no discussion about the wording on the plaque.

The Board's response expressing disapproval of the Trileaf Project #722414 / Honeymoon Trail request was submitted last week. The response was that the State Historic Preservation Board (SHPO) was in favor of the project. Judy Habbeshaw asked what was being discussed. Connie explained it was a request to build a cell tower. After more discussion, it was agreed that a copy of our response will be sent to SHPO.

The possible project of updating the Kanab Fort sign was tabled until our next meeting.

A Board member asked about possibly making a sign-preservation list. That will be discussed at another time.

All agreed that the next meeting will be held Monday, August 7 at 5:30 pm. Joyce made a motion, seconded by Mace that the meeting be adjourned at 6:11 pm. Motion carried.
