

Minutes of the Kanab City Heritage and Historic Preservation Board Meeting

Mace called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Present were:

Motion to approve the April and May 2022 meetings was made by Joyce, seconded by Susan. Motion carried.

Mace opened the Public Comment portion of the meeting. Present were: Linda Alderman-Briscoe, Judy Habbeshaw, and Teresa Trujillo. All three spoke in turn. Their primary concerns seemed to be centered around the advisory capacity and oversight of the Kanab City Heritage and Historic Preservation Board and the Kanab City Museum. Mace closed the Public Comment portion at 6:25 pm.

The first order of business was painting the existing poles at the homes on the Kanab Historic Building Registry. The cost of the paint will be donated. The Kanab LDS 2nd and 4th Ward youth will paint the signs the evening of Wednesday, June 22.

The last order of business at the May 2 meeting was the Heritage Board having an email address so that the public could contact the members with questions or concerns. Emily shared a draft of a possible 'contact us' section through the museum website instead of an email address. The members agreed that it would be less expensive and easier to update. Mace moved and Joyce seconded a motion to move forward with the draft of the 'contact us' section. Action: Members of the Board are to review the draft, provide a headshot photo of themselves and a brief biography to be included in the section.

The Saturday evening, July 23, all-women city council program in conjunction with the plaque placement was discussed. Susan will be in charge of publicity. Mace will supervise sending invitations to members of the community who would be interested (such as the mayor and city council members and the Utah Lt. Governor). Emily and Susan will work together to organize the program. The first order of business at our next meeting will be to finalize the plans for this special event.

As agreed at the May meeting, Emily presented drafts of the standards and documentation for the Kanab Historic Marker Program. We reviewed drafts of both the Kanab Historic Marker Program description and the Kanab Historical Marker

Application. Those documents will be emailed to the members for further review and input which will be discussed at our next meeting.

The Annual Review Documentation will be included on the agenda of our next meeting.

As a way of expressing their appreciation for our service to the community by serving on the Heritage Board, the city council has made arrangements for each of us to receive a free family pool pass to the Kanab City pool. The members expressed gratitude to the City Council for their generosity. We were told this is the first time the city council has done something like this.

There being no further business, Mace made a motion which Susan seconded that the meeting be adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
