

**Kanab City Council Meeting
August 24, 2021
City Council Chambers
26 North 100 East
6:30 PM**

The prayer was offered by Jeff Yates and the pledge was led by Michael East. Mayor Houston called the meeting to order and roll call was taken.

In Attendance: Mayor Robert D Houston, Council Members Arlon Chamberlain, Celeste Meyeres, Michael East, Jeff Yates and Byard Kershaw, Recorder Joe Decker, Attorney Jeff Stott and Treasurer Katherine Ohlwiler.

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Celeste Meyeres and 2nd by Byard Kershaw to approve the August 24, 2021 meeting agenda. Motion passed.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Jeff Yates and 2nd by Celeste Meyeres to approve the meeting minutes from July 27, 2021. Motion passed.

Approval of Accounts Payable Vouchers and Check Registers: A motion was made by Byard Kershaw and 2nd by Jeff Yates to approve the accounts payable vouchers and check registers dated August 3, 2021 in the amount of \$54,237.40; August 11, 2021 in the amount of \$5,701,510.43; August 17, 2021 in the amount of \$81,491.97 and for August 24, 2021 in the amount of \$114,249.62. Motion passed.

Public Comment: Mayor Houston read a email letter submitted by Jim Sanford:

“My name is James Sanford. I live in the ranchos at 1016 W Vermilion dr. We have lived here for 20+ years. Two weeks ago we got flooded again, not a 100 year flood or a 500 year flood but a down pour. The storm drain system is insufficient throughout the Ranchos and needs to be addressed. Down town seems to get all the attention and upgrades. The water in our neighborhood flows down the street and cul-de-sac and floods our lot often due to the clogging and undersized storm drain. If you where to use a trunk line to the the wash at Grand Canyon dr and vermilion dr you could eliminate this flooding problem. We lost over 10 thousand dollars in landscape/ flood control rock we installed with our own funds, on August 12 And the 19th with 2 thunderstorms. The city has known of the problems with flooding in the ranchos and has done nothing to address it. I will be requesting to be on the agenda soon to address these issues and to hear comments from the city council members, And mayoral candidates and our current mayor.
